## Our new class registration system, PACE

We are excited to introduce a new registration program, PACE.

Take a moment to create your user account at

**[ukywhitley.pacecommunity.net](http://ukywhitley.pacecommunity.net)**

PACE will allow you to sign up and pay for classes, at your convenience. Our system will send out reminders and recommend classes, based on your interest. PACE will also track enrollment for our database.

When registering more than one person, each person will need an account. If you are registering minors, that do not have an email, leave that part blank and use your phone number to register them. Or you can add them to your registration. Each person will need to be registered to hold their spot in class. Payment, if required, will secure your spot in the class. You will receive a confirmation email.

The first step and most important step is to set up your user account. This is a simple 5 minute process.

After registering for a class, in the checkout phase- you need to hit checkout twice, to actually be registered.

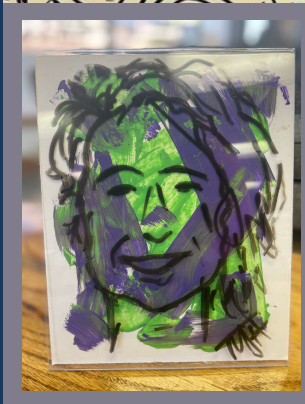
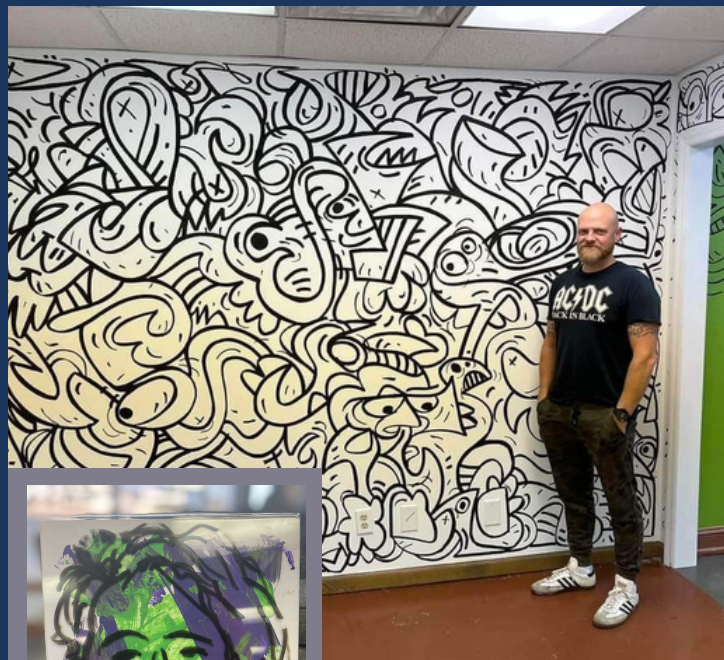

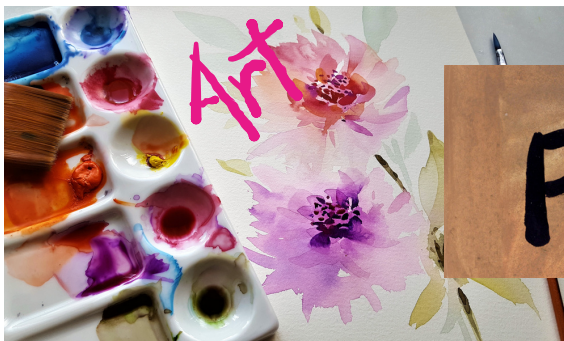

In memory of Marian Colette

In 2012, Dal Macon and Marian Colette's idea of bringing the first Earth Day celebration to Williamsburg, Kentucky, has had a lasting impact on the local community and beyond. Marian's passion for the environment and commitment to making a difference in the community inspired her to organize the event and bring together like-minded individuals to celebrate the beauty and importance of our planet. With the help of Joyce Johnson Rouse, dogwood saplings were given away, and Earth Day decorations adorned the Lane Theatre. This one-time event quickly became a tradition, and the UK Community Arts Extension took over the responsibility in 2014 of organizing the celebration every year. This year's event is a testament to the lasting impact of Marian and her legacy will continue to inspire future generations to take action for a more sustainable future.



May 17, 1946 - November 19, 2022

During her twenties, Marian devoted her time as a School Sister of St. Francis and was an active member of Our Lady of Perpetual Help Catholic Church located in Williamsburg, Kentucky. Marian's community involvement extended far beyond her religious affiliations. She was the founder and director of Whitley County Communities for Children, a regional director for Save the Children, and a GED teacher. Her passion for education and community advocacy made her a trailblazer in Williamsburg and Whitley County. Marian's leadership and dedication to creating positive change in her community continue to inspire others to follow in her footsteps.

## Christian Mansfield

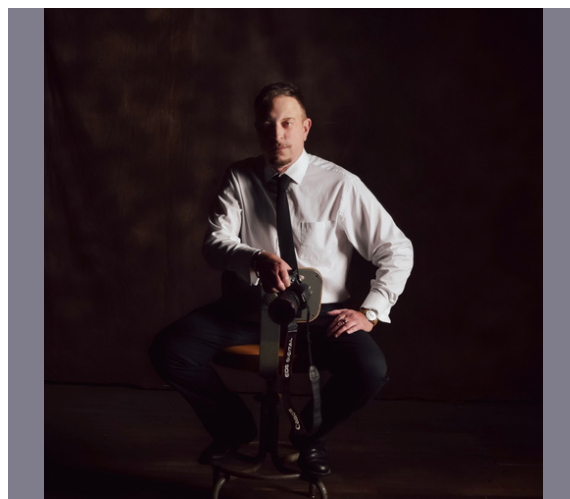
### ABOUT THE PHOTOGRAPHER

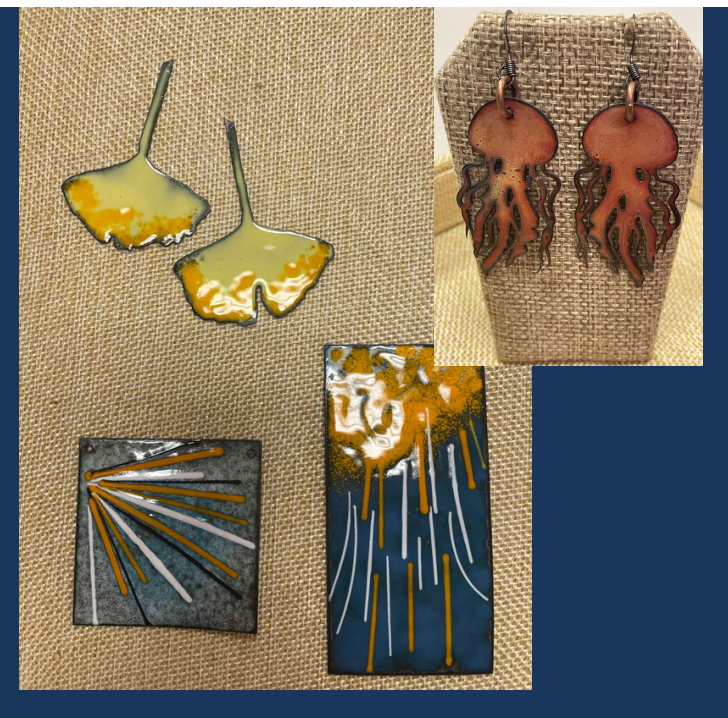

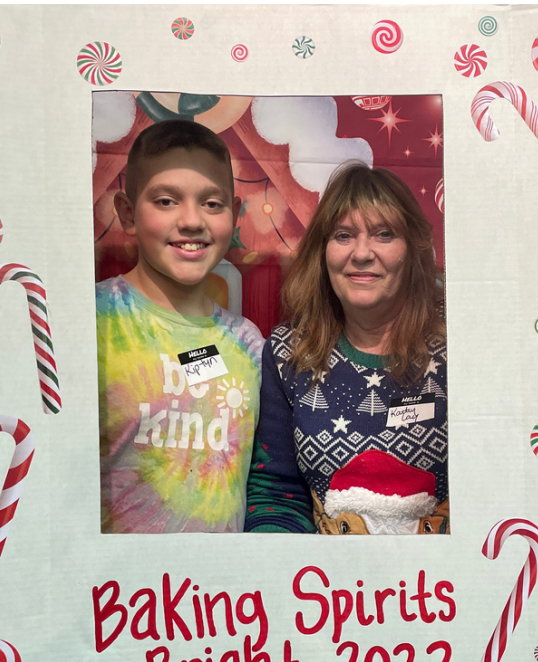

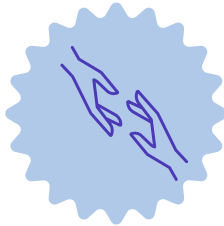
